## Costs (Updated for Sept, 2022) \*\*

**(We are a not-for-profit, unincorporated association – all instructors are volunteers and all monies collected go to benefit the club and its members)**

### **Joining fee:**

*(One time only cost* – includes lifetime local, national and international memberships)

Children 12 & under	<b>\$35</b>
13 years +	<b>\$40</b>

**Insurance:** (Yearly cost per person) **\$15**

**Formal Classes:** (there may be occasional extra training at no extra cost)

Kids, ages 6-9 and beginners (1 hour) **\$35/month**  
(Family Rate: 2 people training = \$30/month each, 3 or more training = \$25/month each)

General (1.5 - 2 hours) **\$40/month**  
(Family Rate: 2 people training = \$35/month each, 3 or more training = \$30/month each)

\*\* If members of the same family are training different lengths of time then the family rate for each category they are training in applies to each of those family members. If people are training less than 2 days per week and find the fees an obstacle please talk to us about it.

**Drop-in:** **\$12/session**

**Kyu gradings** (Max. 2 per year - optional):

All students	<b>\$12</b>
New belt colour	<b>+\$8</b>

\***Other costs** include dogi (training uniform) and personal sparring equipment as needed. Optional camps, tournaments and seminars are also extra.

\*\***NB: Anyone who is dedicated to train, can, regardless of their ability to pay fees – just talk to Sensei Mike or Senpai EJ about it.**
